MATHS

1. *An easy way to learn the tables:* Make 9 different coloured bookmarks of same design and size using pastel paper and write the tables 2 to 10 neatly on them (one table on one bookmark). Decorate your bookmarks and then ring all of them. Carry your bunch of tables with you wherever you go. You will enjoy learning them.
2. Revise all the work done on Numbers (1 to 500). Practice these concepts (number names, forward and backward counting, before, after, in between, increasing and decreasing order) in 3 in 1 notebook.
