- I. **Squares of numbers** – The product of a number with itself is called its square.

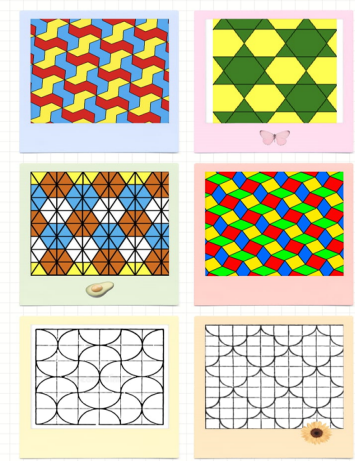
Example – Square of 9 = $9 \times 9 = 81$

- Solar System:** Create a Scratch project that displays the solar system, including all the planets, their orbits, and key features of each planet. Use animation, sound, and text to provide information about each planet, such as its size, distance from the sun, and unique features.
- Life Cycle of a Butterfly:** Create a Scratch project that shows the life cycle of a butterfly. Use animation, narration and interactive elements to show the four stages of the butterfly's life and explain the role of each stage in the butterfly's life cycle with the help of text.

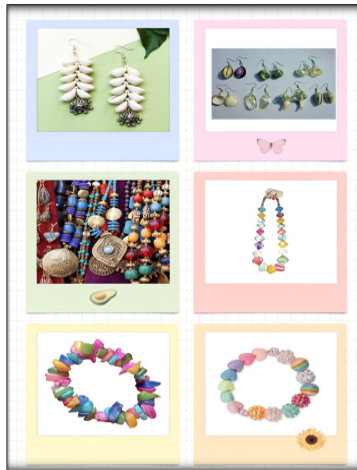
