


Art is a form of human expression. The coincidence of similarities in art forms that were never influenced by one another historically only shows the oneness of us all.






SECTION 3: ISA ACTION PLAN



Brief and clear description of Activity that will help in attaining the projected learning outcomes:

Students will be introduced to the world of Warli art, and traditional arts of Korea and South Africa through a workshop.

- All students of class 5 will participate in a quiz on the history and culture leading to the different arts in question.
- -They will further participate in an Art Competition whereby they will make Greeting Cards using any of the three arts learnt.
- Students of classes 6 will decorate ceramic mugs using Warli art. Students of class 7 will make Korean face masks using Papier Mache, while students of class 8 will design and paint t-shirts/terracotta sheets using African tribal art.
- •The prize winning objects created by students will be displayed in an Art Exhibition during a Special Assembly on the World Heritage Day.




