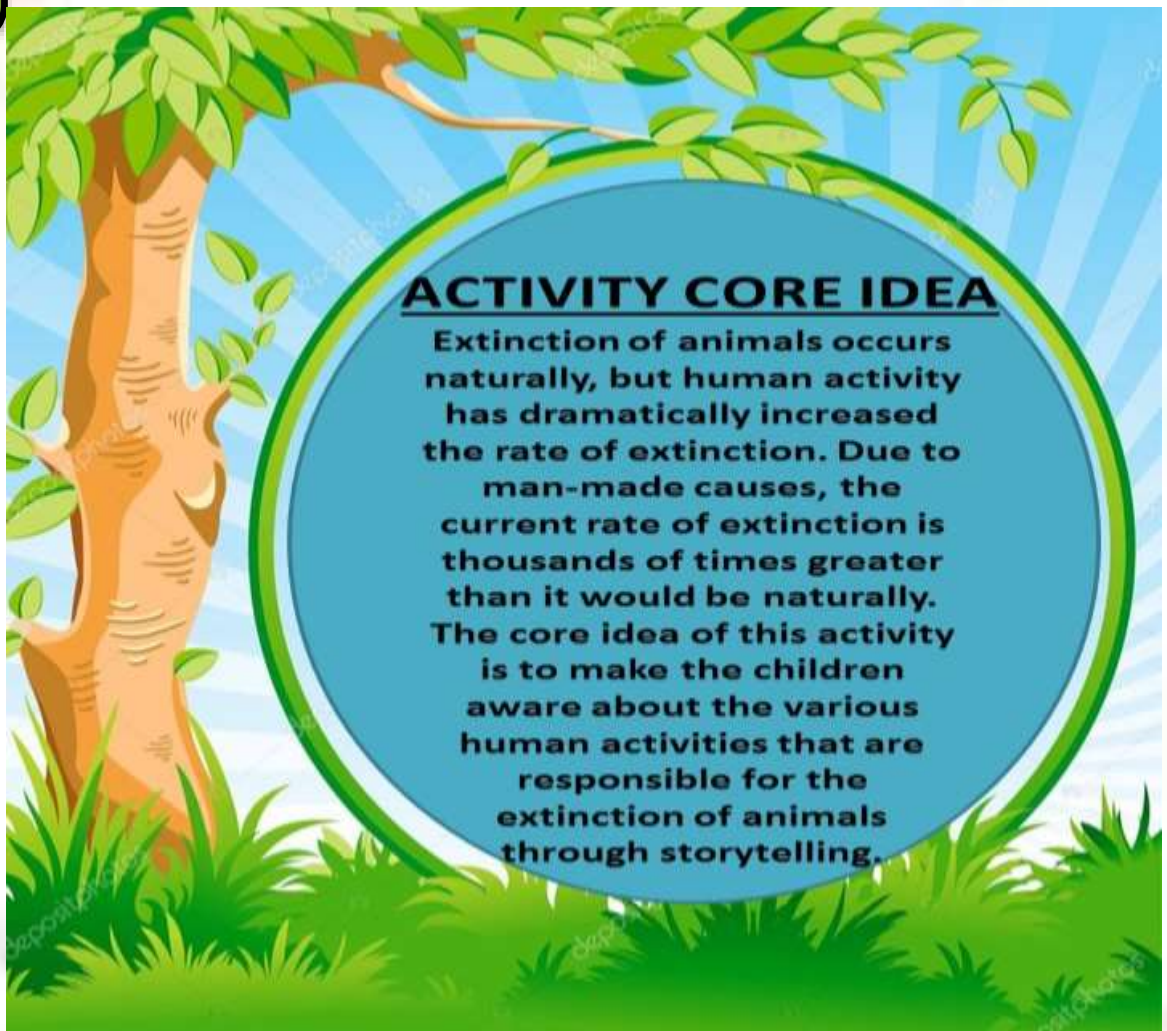
Teacher's Report
