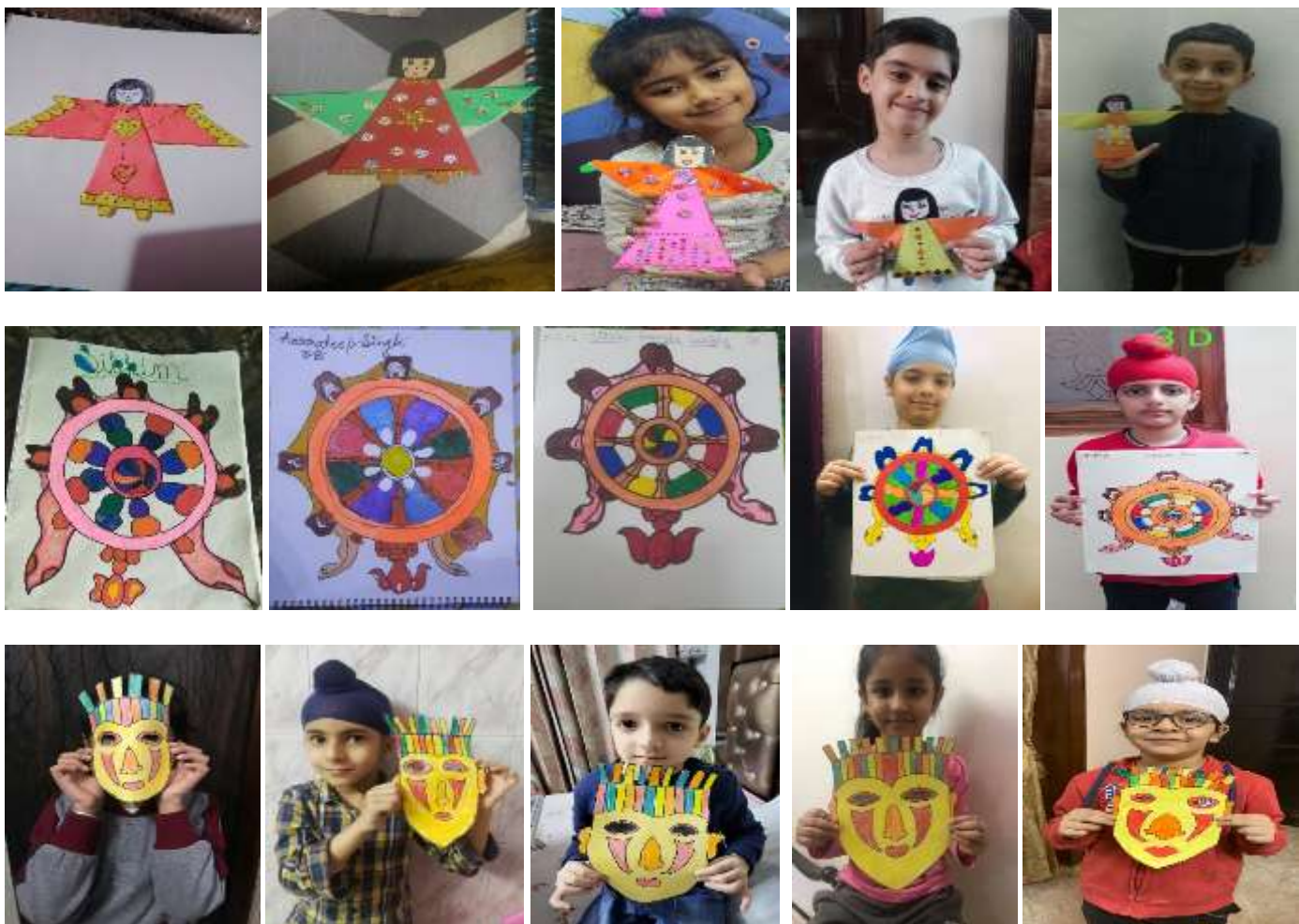
### EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT

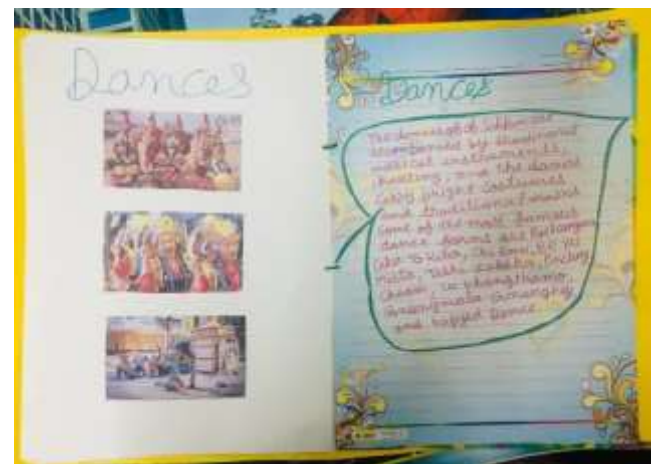
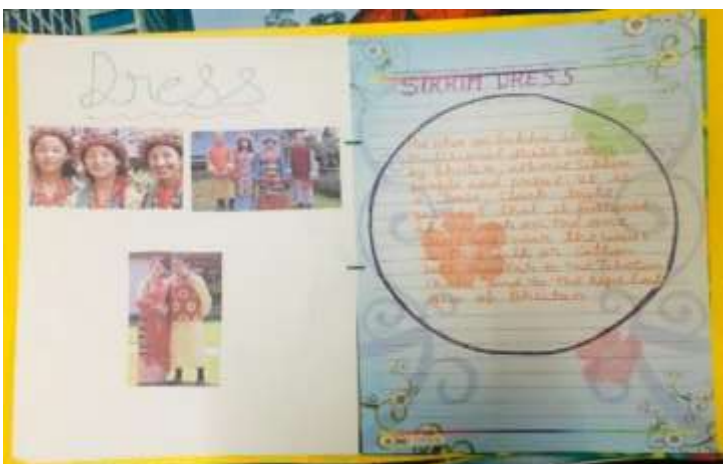
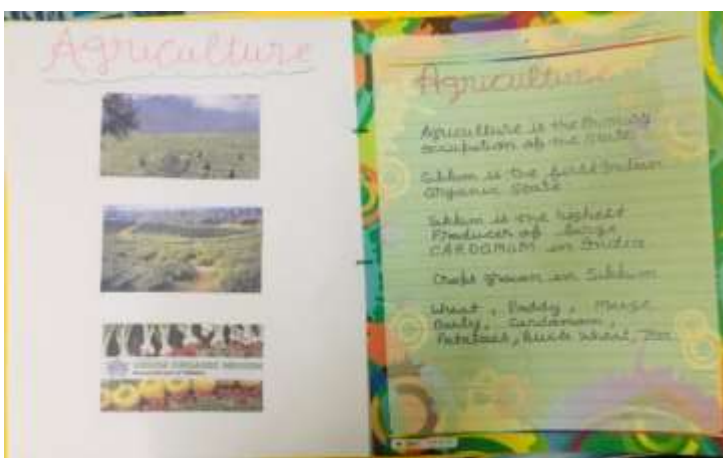


#### CLASS III

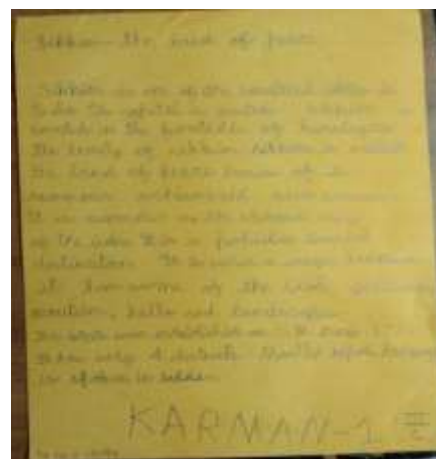
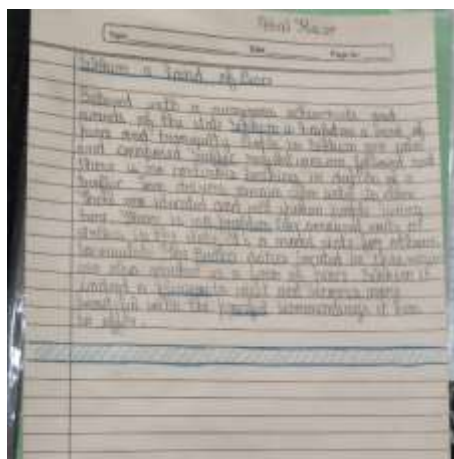
##### **SIKKIM, THE LAND OF PEACE- PARAGRAPH WRITING**
