



## **Dynamics of School Education w.r.t NEP 2020 & NCFSE**

Affordability, Quality, Accessibility, and Accountability are the pillars of today's Education. Also, to align with sustainable development goals for 2020 and bring improvement in school and college education through a holistic, multidisciplinary, and flexible approach. Keeping the same agenda in mind, a workshop on the 'Dynamics of School Education w.r.t NEP 2020 & NCFSE' was held at Mata Jai Kaur Public School on 23/11/23. Sumit Bhardwaj, an Internationally Certified Neuro-Linguistic Programming (NLP) Trainer, led the workshop in collaboration with Collins Smart Start Publishing Division focused on the National Curriculum Framework 2023.

The NCF 2023 in sync with the NEP 2020, focuses on developing students' skills across all five learning domains - physical, socioemotional, ethical, cognitive, language and literacy, and aesthetic and cultural. In his discussion, Mr. Bhardwaj stressed the role of a teacher by stating that everything starts with a teacher. His emphasis was on adopting innovative teaching strategies and creating student-centred classrooms and how competency-based education will prepare learners to take advantage of modern opportunities. It was also discussed how art should be integrated into all subjects.

The workshop also highlighted the importance of assessment in tracking a student's progress at every level of school- primary, middle, and secondary. All levels of assessment, whether primary, middle, or senior, need to employ a variety of methods. Student learning should be made more meaningful and joyful by incorporating both formative and summative assessment methods. For the primary wing, Collins Learning provided sample copies of books designed according to the NCF 2023. A question-and-answer session followed. Throughout the workshop, teachers connected the NCF guidelines to their subject pedagogical approaches with enthusiasm.
