Swachta Abhiyan was initiated in MJKPS on 2 September'24. A special assembly was conducted where children were apprised about the importance of cleanliness around us. A small one act was dramatized by the students of class V. It was followed by a talk on ideology behind Swachta Abhiyan. Students of classes III, IV & V took a pledge to keep their surroundings clean.





Cleanliness Drive

Hygiene should be a part and parcel of life and to develop good habits one must be extremely disciplined and consistent in life. With this idea, the students and staff members were encouraged to keep their surroundings clean by maintaining class cupboards, classroom cleanliness, staffroom on each floor was put upright and washrooms were set in a proper manner and were well-cleaned and disinfected. The community outreach student in-charges were encouraged to take rounds and make students aware of the need to maintain cleanliness. Overall, this brought an impact upon the students in a positive direction towards bringing a change in them.









Hygiene Awareness

An initiative to raise handwashing awareness among Nursery, KG and Class I students, an activity focused on teaching proper **hand hygiene**, essential for preventing illness and promoting cleanliness was undertaken. Students of class I created awareness and demonstrated the correct



handwashing technique using soap and water, highlighting the steps to clean the palms, back of the hands, fingers, and nails. As part of the demonstration, they applied glitter particles on hands to denote germs. This was followed by a colouring activity to let children absorb the technique. Students participated enthusiastically, practicing the steps and asking questions to deepen their understanding. Students of Pre-Primary and class I prepared a hygiene kit. They were explained the usefulness of different things kept in the kit. Children were made to understand the importance of personal hygiene. In continuation of the activity, the correct way of brushing teeth, the do's and don'ts of brushing regularly, correct way of holding a toothbrush, the points to be kept in mind while buying new brush and discarding old brushes were discussed. Importance of maintaining oral hygiene was emphasized.

Slogan Writing & Painting Competition

As a part of Swachhta Pakhwada, a slogan writing and painting competition was organized for classes IV and V. The best 5 entries from each class were selected by the Art teacher, Ms. Rajrani. She then selected best 3 from those to be rewarded on the final day of the event. Later, an





exhibition was held in the Art room wherein the prize-winning entries were displayed. Some very useful best out of waste material created by the students were also exhibited. As a culmination activity, an award ceremony was conducted on the Friday, 13 September in which all the students who won prizes during the Swachta Abhiyan were awarded.
